

[F] Other Options

1) Off-set sanders are more comfortable to hold and available in slower speeds models.

2) Random Orbital Sanders

a) electric - has 3/16" random orbit

**b) pneumatic - has 3/32" random orbit
(this produces better results)**

- Compressor requirements:

At 1200 rpm with 90 psi and

14-16 cfm a minimum of a

3 hp, 30 gallon tank is needed.

3) Extensions are available for drills and off-set sanders (they are expensive)

4) Sanding gloves (mittens) with velcro

a) ideal for conforming to shapes

b) good for static inside sanding (not while bowl is turning)

(Lathe off for your safety !)

5) Sanding paddles with velcro sponge available

a) these and the gloves can be home made.

[G] Advantages of inertia sanders (self powered sanding)

1) lighter to hold

2) slower speed for better results

3) eliminates almost all radial scratch marks

(even rapidly moving hand held sandpaper leaves radial grit marks)

4) extension handles are available
